**ORDER**

After introduction of the Tripura Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Reservation of vacancies in Service and Posts) First Amendment Act, 1997 read with The Persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation) Act, 1995 the percentage of reservation for Physically Handicapped (Disabled Persons) has increased from 2% to 3%. Consequently, Physically Handicapped Persons recruited in Government Service as well as in Public Sector Undertakings etc. (and Ex-Serviceman) belonging to ST, SC and UR categories are being adjusted against the points of ST,SC and UR categories respectively.

The **HUNDRED POINT ROSTER** has accordingly been modified in the aforesaid amendment act, for direct recruitment in the services under the State Government and in Public Sector Undertakings etc receiving financial assistance from the State Government Physically Handicapped and Ex-Serviceman of ST,SC and UR categories shall be accommodated respectively against the points of the 100 Point Roster. For them, the 100 Point Roster shall stand extended upto 400 points, i.e. upto the 4th Cycle of the 100 Point Roster. As per provision of Sec.33 of the Persons with Disabilities(Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation) Act, 1995, categories of Disabled persons have been identified and the percentage of reservation has been earmarked as 3% which has to be adjusted at the ratio of 1% each for the persons suffering from:-

- i) blindness or low vision;
- ii) Hearing impaired; and
- iii) Loco motor disability or cerebral palsy.

The above categories of disabled persons may be adjusted against the posts indicated in the Schedule under Sl.No.12 of the Tripura Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Reservation of Vacancies in Services and Posts) First Amendment Act, 1997 as follows:-

Thereafter Point No.44 (SC) in 5th Cycle may be reserved for one who suffers from blindness or low vision; Point No.45(ST) in the 6th Cycle may be reserved for locomotor and point No.44(SC) in the 9th Cycle may be reserved for person of locomotor disability.

Provided that the appropriate authority may, having regard to the type or work carried on in any department or establishment, by notification subject to such conditions, if any, as may be specified in such notification, exempt any establishment from the above provision.

It is clarified that if any recruitment year any vacancy for the persons with disability cannot be filled up due to non-availability of a suitable person with disability or, for any other sufficient reason, such vacancy shall be carried forward in the succeeding recruitment year and if in the succeeding recruitment year also suitable person with disability is not available, it may first be filled by interchange among the three categories and only when there is no person with disability available for the post in that year, the employer shall fill up the vacancy by appointment of a person, other than a person with disability.

Provided that if the nature of vacancies in an establishment is such that a given category of person can not be employed, the vacancies may be interchanged among the three categories of disabled persons within the respective category of candidates reserved for, with the prior approval of the appropriate authority.

These instructions will come into effect from the date of publication.

Tribe category and un-reserved category shall be accommodated respectively against the points reserved for the Sch.Castes, the Sch.Tribes and the Un-reserved points of the 100 Point Roster. However, where posts are more than 400, the roster point shall stand extended upto 400 point to accommodate all categories i.e. Sch.Castes, Sch.Tribes and Un-reserved. But where posts are less than 400, the reservation will be on replacement basis against the posts year-marked and shown category-wise i.e. Sch. Castes, Sch.Tribes and Un-reserved. The reservation for the Physically Handicapped and Ex-Serviceman shall be made according to the post based 100 Point Roster as well as the replacement roster in the following manner:-
