INS 2TD is to demonstrate a technology. It is a pre cursor to the INS 2B satellite. INS 2B is a joint satellite of India and Bhutan.

- Mindtree founders Sushmita & Subroto Bagchi and Radha & NS Parthasarathy make Rs 425 crore donation to IISc, Bengaluru to help build medical school & 800bed multi-speciality hospital.
- Ilker Ayci, former chairman of Turkish Airlines, named new CEO & MD of Air India.
- Sandeep Bakhshi, MD & CEO of ICICI Bank, named Business Standard Banker of the Year 2020-21.
- Retail inflation, as measured by the consumer price index (CPI), rises to 6.01% in January. Wholesale price-based inflation declines to 12.96% in January.
- The Ministry of Tribal Affairs has approved a budget of 2.26 crores for the India's second-largest fair- "Medaram Jathara 2022 Festivals". Medaram Jathara is the second-largest fair in India, after the Kumbh Mela. Festival will be held from February 16, 2022 to February 19, 2022. Medaram Jathara is the state festival of Telangana. It is held for four days. The festival is organised by Telangana's second-largest tribal community called the Koya tribe. Medaram Jathara festival is conducted in honour of Goddesses Sammakka and Saralamma.
- Fintech Open Month started on February 7, 2022. It is a first-of-its-kind initiative that brings together the Fintech professionals & enthusiasts, regulators, industry leaders, start-up community, and developers on a common platform. It was started by NITI Aayog. Summit was inaugurated by Union Minister Ashwini Vaishnaw in the presence of Vice Chairman of NITI Aayog, Dr Rajiv Kumar.
- Guru Ravidas Jayanti was observed on February 16, 2022, in the honour of birthday of Guru Ravidas. This festival is celebrated with joviality in North India, specifically in Punjab. The day marks the birthday of Indian mystic poet-saint, Ravidas and is celebrated on Magh Purnima.
- On Feb 16, 2022, Government approves 'New India Literacy Programme, a new scheme of Adult Education for FYs 2022-27"; term "Adult Education" to be replaced with "Education For All". The Ministry of Education (MoE) has announced the 'New India Literacy Programme' for the next five years, to cover all aspects of adult education. The ministry has decided to use the term 'Education for All' instead of 'Adult Education,' because the previous term didn't represent all non-literates who are in the age group of 15 years and above.
  - This programme is expected to cost Rs 1037.90 crore between 2022 and 2027, with the central government providing Rs 700 crore and the states providing Rs 337.90 crore, respectively.

- The DefExpo 2022 is scheduled to be held from March 10 to March 13, 2022. DefExpo exhibition is India's biennial marquee event for defence manufacturing industry. The event will be held in Gandhinagar, Gujarat, for the first time.
- On Feb 17, 2022, Nepal became first country to deploy India's UPI (Unified Payments Interface) platform for digitalisation of cash transactions
- On Feb 17, 2022, First meeting of G20 Finance Ministers & Central Bank Governors under G20 Presidency of Indonesia held.
- Government has appointed Vice Admiral (retd) G Ashok Kumar as the nation's first
  national maritime security coordinator with the view of strengthening the country's
  maritime security.
- On February 19, 2022, Asia's largest Bio-CNG plant was virtually inaugurated by Prime Minister Narendra Modi in Indore. Indore is considered as one of the cleanest cities India.
- The National Institute of Animal Biotechnology, Hyderabad, has developed the "Fluorine Doped Tin Oxide (FTO) electrode fabricated with reduced Graphene Oxide (rGO)" to detect the Japanese Encephalitis Virus. Japanese Encephalitis Virus (JEV) is the leading cause of mosquito-borne encephalitis in Western Pacific and South-East Asia. It is often misdiagnosed as Dengue. There is no cure available for JEV. Thus, its early detection is essential in order to mitigate a breakout.
- On February 18, 2022, Ministry of Housing and Urban affairs (MoHUA) interacted with the beneficiaries of Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (Urban) in virtual mode, under the "Labharthiyon se Rubaroo" initiative. In the session, Secretary of MoHUA interacted with PMAY(U) beneficiaries from Assam, Kerala and Jharkhand to know about their empowerment stories and life transforming experiences after getting a pucca house of their own.

The summit was co-chaired by Charles Michel, President of the European Council, and Macky Sall, President of Senegal, who was also the Chairperson of the African Union at the time. The immediate task is ensuring that vaccines are distributed equally. EU and AU will work together for the allocation, procurement, and deployment methods for medical products.

- On February 18, 2022, India-UAE sign Comprehensive Economic Partnership Agreement (CEPA). India and the United Arab Emirates (UAE) have signed a trade agreement that will decrease import duties on the majority of Indian exports to the UAE. The Comprehensive Economic Partnership Agreement (CEPA) is the government's first significant trade agreement since 2014.
- According to UNCTAD's Global Trade Update published on February 17th, global trade in goods continued strong in 2021, and trade in services finally returned to the levels of pre-COVID-19. Global trade touched \$28.5 trillion which is a record level in 2021, according to the research.
- In its new guidelines on data security, Information and Broadcasting (I&B) Ministry has prohibited the sharing of secret or top-secret documents by its officials over Internet. They have also been asked not to use digital assistant devices like Amazon's Echo, Google Home in office, Apple's HomePod and turn off digital assistants, including Siri and Alexa, in their smartphones or watches. Officials have also been mandated to deposit their smart phones outside the meeting room during discussions on classified issues.
- On February 18, 2022, diversified energy major Indian Oil announced that, it has installed more than 1,000 electric vehicle charging stations (EVCS) in India. Indian Oil is all set to provide EV charging facilities at 10,000 fuel stations in upcoming three years. This will provide confidence to customers for an uninterrupted drive and to automobile manufacturers in enhancing production of electric vehicles. Indian Oil installed its first EV charger at Nagpur, for public in 2017. Now, its

- charging points are present across 500 towns and cities including multiple state and national highways.
- A team of researchers recently discovered a new species of bent-toed gecko or lizard, from Umroi Military station in Ri-Bhoi district of Meghalaya. The new species of Gecko or lizard belongs to the family of Cyrtodactylus exercitus ('exercitus' means army, in Latin). It has been named to honour the valour of Indian Army for their services to India.
- Under "Operation Nanhe Farishte", the Railway Protection Force (RPF) have rescued more than 1,000 kids from Railway stations across India, in the month of January, 2022. It saved 1,045 children who were found alone or were abandoned at the railway stations. Out of all, 701 were boys and 344 were girls.
- On February 19, 2022, PM flags off 100 'kisan drones' of Garuda Aerospace in different parts of the country for spraying pesticides and other farm materials
- Mumbai to host International Olympic Committee session in 2023
- 58th Munich Security Conference (MSC) organised in Germany on Feb 18-20.
- On February 19, 2022, Honorable Prime Minister inaugurates municipal solid waste based "Gobar-Dhan (Bio-CNG) Plant" in Indore, Madhya Pradesh.
- Centre to launch doorstep distribution drive 'Meri Policy Mere Hath' for PMFBY (Pradhan Mantri Fasal Beema Yojana) agriculture insurance scheme.
- India sweep T20 series 3-0 aginst West Indies.
- On February 20, 2022, Winter Olympics conclude in Beijing; Norway tops medals tally followed by Germany and China.
- UN celebrates World Day of Social Justice celebrated on Feb 20; theme: 'Achieving Social Justice through Formal Employment'.
- Coal India Ltd wins 'Most Dependable Public Sector in India' award from Assocham.
- Lok Sabha Speaker Om Birla leading Parliamentary delegation to UAE from Feb 21 to 25,2022.
- Statehood Day of Mizoram and Arunachal Pradesh celebrated on Feb 20; both were Union Territories before becoming states on February 20, 1987.
- Govt. organising 'Vigyan Sarvatra Pujyate' commemoration from February 22 to 28 to celebrate Science and Technology achievements over past 75 years.
- Assam government is set to launch a four-year mentorship programme called Project Arohan. This project will be launched to provide guidance to students and boost their skills. For this project, Assam Chief Minister Himanta Biswa Sarma met Anita Rajan, CEO of Tata STRIVE, to sought their cooperation on this project. Tata STRIVE is a skill development programme of Tata Trusts.
- The Taj Mahotsav 2022 is scheduled to happen from March 20 to March 29, 2022. It is a 10-day cultural festival, held in Agra each year. It is the most well-known art, craft, gourmet, and culture festival, held at the crossroads of winter and spring.
- The Madhya Pradesh Kala Parishad organizes the Khajuraho Dance Festival, a one-week classical dance festival held annually beside the Khajuraho temples located in the Chhatarpur district of Madhya Pradesh. This festival takes place from 20th to 26<sup>th</sup> February.
- The International Mother Language Day 2022 is being observed on February 21. The day is observed every year for promoting awareness on linguistic and cultural

- diversity. The theme of International Mother Language Day 2022 is "Using technology for multilingual learning: Challenges and opportunities".
- A study has revealed that moths are essential for pollination in northeast India's Himalayan environment. The study established that 91 species of moths are pollinators of 21 different species of plants in Arunachal Pradesh and Sikkim in the north-eastern Himalayas.
  - The city of Mumbai will be hosting the 2023 International Olympic Committee session. This event will see the election for the 2030 Winter Olympics host country and the sports programme for the Olympic Games scheduled in Los Angeles for the year 2028. This IOC session will be held either in the months of May or June the next year. The announcement confirms that India will host the prestigious IOC meeting for the first time since the year 1983. This will help in bringing in engagement between the Olympic Movement and the youths of the nation.
  - As India gets to host this session, India will be front-runners to host the 2030 Youth Olympics and can push for the 2036 Summer Olympics.
- According to Union Minister of State of Prime Minister's office, Jitendra Singh, central
  government was planning to start 'Purple Revolution' in Ramban district of Jammu
  and Kashmir. Purple revolution will be planned by encouraging lavender cultivation
  under CSIR-IIIM's Aroma Mission through the Ministry of Science and Technology. It
  will be planned on lines of Doda and Reasi districts.
- On February 21, 2022, DCGI grants Emergency Use Authorisation to COVID-19 vaccine Corbevax for children between 12-18 years of age group
- Ranveer Singh (83) and Kriti Sanon (Mimi) win Dadasaheb Phalke International Film Festival Award 2022 in the Best Actor and Best Actress category.
- Air forces of India, Oman to conduct Eastern Bridge-VI exercise in Jodhpur from Feb 21 to 25,2022.
- On February 21, 2022,6th Anniversary of the launch of Shyama Prasad Mukherji Rurban Mission observed. Marking the 6<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Shyama Prasad Mukherji Rurban Mission, ministry of Rural Development approved 296 clusters under it.
- On February 21, 2022, IRCTC, NPCI, Bank of Baroda (BOB) Financial Solutions launch 'IRCTC BoB RuPay Contactless Credit Card' for railway customers.
- On February 21, 2022,16-year-old Indian chess Grandmaster R Praggnanandhaa defeats world No. 1 Magnus Carlsen of Norway in 8th round of Airthings Masters rapid online chess tournament.
- Japan has launched its first hydrogen-powered train. This unveiling is seen as a step towards the country's objective of becoming carbon neutral by 2050. The hydrogen-fuelled train will be tested in the country in March. "Hybari" the two-car train costs over USD 35 million or 4 billion yen and can go up to 140 kilometers or 87 miles at a top speed of 100 kilometers per hour on a single hydrogen refuelling. The train has been developed by East Japan Railway in association with Hitachi and Toyota Motor Corporation.
- On February 22, 2022, President Ram Nath Kovind has inaugurated the 'Vigyan Sarvatra Pujyate programme' in virtual mode. Vigyan Sarvatra Pujyate is a weeklong, nationwide programme of competitions and lectures for school students and collegians. To organise this programme, Union Ministry of Science and Technology has selected three institutions in Madhya Pradesh. MP Council of Science and

- Technology (MPCST) will hold the event in Bhopal, SGSITS College in Indore and Rani Durgavati University in Jabalpur.
- Storm Eunice sparked the first-ever red weather warning in London on February 19, 2022. It was one of the most powerful storms in Europe since 1984, when the Great Storm hit Britain and northern France.
- On 20<sup>th</sup> February, the World Day of Social Justice is observed annually. The United Nations General Assembly declared 20 February as the World Day of Social Justice, which was accepted on 26 November 2007, and observed annually since 2009. 'Achieving Social Justice through Formal Employment' is the theme of World Day of Social Justice 2022.
- With elections in Manipur being scheduled from 27<sup>th</sup> February to 3<sup>rd</sup> March, the candidates are holding a unique flag hoisting ceremony in their constituencies before embarking on campaigning to the people of the state. This ritual is unique to Manipur, is practiced by people of all races, political parties, religions, and communities. Generally, on an auspicious date, this ceremony is held in the courtyard of the respective candidate's home. The event consists of a priest's prayers, hoisting of the party flag by the candidate, and blessings from the elders of the community. The scale of the ceremony varies from one candidate to the other.
- A draft data policy has been published by the central government. This policy states
  that all data collected, maintained, and generated, by every government ministry
  and agency shall be open and shareable. The government could also monetize and
  earn from detailed datasets that have undergone value addition. The policy has been
  named "Draft India Data Accessibility & Use Policy 2022."
- Vedanta Ltds. Cairn Oil & Gas has discovered oil in the Barmer district of Rajasthan.
  The company has notified the Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas and Directorate
  General of Hydrocarbons (DGH) about this discovery. This oil was discovered by
  Cairn Oil & Gas in a block that was given to them under the Open Acreage Licensing
  Policy (OALP). This discovery is the third such discovery that the company has
  notified under the Open Acreage Licensing Policy. 'Durga' is the name given to this
  discovery.
- A new naval air defence system named 'C-Dome' has been successfully tested by Israel. The C-Dome is a naval variant of the Iron Dome of Israel. The Iron Dome is a missile system of Israel that is used to destroy and intercept missiles and rockets of short-range from the Gaza Strip.
- On February 22, 2022, Centre extends National Means-cum-Merit Scholarship Scheme (NMMSS) till 2025-26; provides scholarships to meritorious students of economically weaker sections. There will be minimum changes in the eligibility criteria like increasing the income ceiling from the present Rs 1.5 lakh to Rs 3.5 lakh per annum. Also, PM CARES for Children Scheme Extended up to February 28, 2022.
- On February 22, 2022, Union Minister Giriraj Singh releases Rural Connectivity GIS (Geographic Information System) Data in Public Domain; that will benefit entrepreneurs. Also, Union Minister Giriraj Singh launches Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana – Gramin (PMAYG) Dashboard.

- On February 22, 2022, 34th Federation Cup volleyball championships in Bhubaneswar: Services (men'), Kerala (women's) win titles.
- A group of archaeologists have found 5,300-year-old skull in a Spanish tomb, that shows possibly the oldest evidence of ear surgery. Several cut marks are visible in the skull across the left ear canal. This implies that, surgery may have been done to relieve pain.
- In the city of Mumbai, the Financial Stability and Development Council's (FSDC) 25th meeting was held. This meeting was held under the chair of Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman.
- The first bank to set up shop in the metaverse is JP Morgan. A lounge in Decentraland, a blockchain-based community has been set up by the largest bank in the United States. Users can create virtual avatars and rooms, and travel in the 'Onyx Lounge,' of the Ethereum-based services it offers. A digitized image of the bank's CEO, Jamie Dimon, is also displayed in the lounge.

RBI caution against sRide App, stating that this firm was operating a semi-closed pre-paid instrument, without receiving authorization from the central bank, under Payment and Settlement Systems Act, 2007.
- Indian Air Force (IAF) and Royal Air Force of Oman (RAFO) are taking part in a bilateral exercise names "Eastern Bridge- VI", in a bid to booster operational efficiency through interoperability. This is the 6<sup>th</sup> edition of the exercise, taking place at Air Force Station Jodhpur.
- On February 23, 2022, Union Minister of Health and Family Welfare Mansukh Mandaviya releases reports of Institute for Competitiveness (affiliated to Harvard Business School) on India's COVID-19 Vaccination Programme
- On February 23, 2022, Tripura CM Biplab Kumar Deb inaugurates Second Bangladesh Film Festival in Agartala.
- On February 22, 2022, Professor Neena Gupta, conferred the Ramanujan Prize for Young Mathematicians 2021. Neena Gupta is a mathematician from Indian Statistical Institute in Kolkata. She conferred the award for her outstanding work in affine

- algebraic geometry and commutative algebra. The Ramanujan Prize for Young Mathematicians is a mathematics prize, that is awarded annually by "International Centre for Theoretical Physics" in Italy.
- On February 9, 2022, Iran unveiled a new missile called "Khaibar Buster Missile", which is capable of hitting nearby US bases and Israel. It has a range of 900 miles.
- On February 23, 2022, the union minister for Ports, Shipping & Waterways and AYUSH, Sarbananda Sonowal inaugurated "Nikarshan Sadan Dredging Museum".
   The Nikarshan Sadan Museum is built by "Dredging Corporation of India", at DCI campus in Visakhapatnam.
- A joint team of scientists from IIT Delhi and Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO), successfully demonstrated Quantum Key Distribution Link, for the first time in India. Quantum Key Distribution link will be created between Prayagraj and Vindhyachal in Uttar Pradesh, for a distance of around 100 km. Quantum key distribution is a secure communication method, that implements a cryptographic protocol comprising of components of quantum mechanics.
- Jammu & Kashmir's Lieutenant Governor Manoj Sinha has approved a foreign direct investment (FDI) policy for the union territory with a foreign stake of a minimum of 51 percent. - On February 24, 2022, Central Excise Day observed on Feb 24; commemorates the Central Excise and Salt Act enacted on 24th February 1944

- On February 24, 2022, Rural Development & Panchayati Raj Minister Giriraj Singh launches Ombudsperson App for MNREGA. This app will help the Ombudsman in carrying out their duties in a transparent and accountable manner.

- The Intracortical Visual Prosthesis (ICVP) is a type of implant that bypasses the optic nerves and the retina to link directly to the brain's visual cortex. At Rush University Medical Center, this was successfully placed surgically in the study's first participant. The surgery that was conducted is a part of Phase I Feasibility Study of an Intracortical Visual Prosthesis for Blind People. The ICVP system was developed by a team which is led by Philip R. Troyk, executive director of Illinois Institute of Technology's Pritzker Institute of Biomedical Science and Engineering.

- The Indian Institute of Technology Madras Research Park in association with the National Institute of Ocean Technology (NIOT) hosted the "OCEANS 2022 conference". OCEANS conference is a bi-annual event of global marine researchers. It was hosted in India, for the first time. Department of Ocean Engineering is coordinating the OCEANS 2022 conference, on behalf of Marine Technology Society and Institution of Electrical & Electronics Engineering (IEEE) Ocean Engineering Society.
- 'Chandrayaan-2 Large Area Soft X-ray Spectrometer (CLASS)' payload of Chandrayaan-2 Orbiter detected solar proton events recently. The Solar Proton Events significantly increase the radiation exposure to humans in space.
- According to an annual report which has been published by the prominent US
  Chamber of Commerce's Global Innovation Policy Center, India's total IP score has
  risen from 38.4 percent to 38.6 percent, and the country is now ranked 43 out of 55
  countries on the International Intellectual Property Index. The overall score of India
  has increased from 38.40 percent (19.20 out of 50) in the ninth edition of this report
  to 38.64 percent (19.32 out of 50) in the latest edition.
- Honorable President Shri Ram Nath Kovind inaugurates year-long celebration marking 400th birth anniversary of Ahom General Lachit Borphukan in Guwahati

The two-dose vaccine of Medicago can be given to adults who are aged between 18 to 64, but little data is available on the shots received by people aged 65 and above. Covifenz is the name given to this vaccine.
- Maharishi Dayanand Saraswati Jayanti 2022 is being celebrated on February 26, 2022. Maharishi Dayanand Saraswati was born on February 12, 1824. According to traditional Hindu calendar, he was born on the Dashami Tithi of Phalguna Krishna Paksha. Thus, in 2022, occasion is being celebrated February 26.
- In October 2019, Anoop Kumar Mendiratta became the first serving judge to be appointed as Union Law Secretary, among 60 candidates. On February 25, 2022, he became the first Union Law Secretary to be appointed as a judge in High Court.
- On February 24, 2022, the Deputy Chief Minister of Delhi, Manish Sisodia, announced that Delhi will get India's first e-waste eco-park. First electronic-waste eco-friendly park will be set up in Delhi, to handle the increasing e-waste.
