

CAREER TIPS



What to Read in the Newspaper?

When you sit to read the newspaper, it is important that you know which news is important from the examination point of view. So, go through the GK section of past 3-4 years question papers of the exam that you are targeting. This will give you an idea of the nature of questions being asked in the exam.

The study of the newspaper may be divided according to the sections commonly seen in the papers.

- a) Front Page: The front page is reserved for the most important news. However, some newspapers today devote large spaces in the front page to cover sensationalist news. So, you need to be good at identifying the important part & filtering out the irrelevant one.
 - City and Regional News: This section is not important.
 - Editorial and Opinion: These are important for widening your knowledge base, improving language skills, understanding key issues etc. This section is very useful for GD phase of MBA admission but has limited utility for objective type GK questions, as they emphasize more on analysis than facts.
 - National and International News: These are important from examination point of view.
 - Business and Economy: This section is critical, especially so for MBA aspirants as you can expect a majority of the questions in current GK from it.
 - Sports: Each paper has at least 2-3 questions related to major international tournaments across various sports.

How to Study the Newspaper?

The newspaper is not to be read like a novel, i.e. in a leisurely manner! You must devote a minimum of 1-1.5 hours every day, to cover all aspects of the newspaper comprehensively.

Taking Notes

This is the most important part of studying the newspaper. It is recommended to purchase a 5-subject notebook or divide one in 5 parts, with the following broad sections:

- Economy and Business In this section, note down details of the latest budget, latest trends in macroeconomic indicators like inflation, GDP, latest business mergers and acquisitions, new appointments of head of business, etc. Please do not waste time in noting down latest figures of inflation, tax collected etc. as it is unlikely that a question may be asked from them.
- <u>Politics</u> In it, note down new laws, bills and constitutional amendments etc. Also, keep a note of recently held or upcoming elections and recently launched schemes by the Union Government. Note down the names of any new

- appointees at high positions in the executive, legislature and judiciary.
- <u>International News</u> Take down facts related to conflicts, national elections, regional treaties, global meetings and their agendas etc. Also, keep noting down facts related to India's foreign relations, economic ties, political conflicts, bilateral and multilateral relations etc.
- **Sport** From the sport section, note down the names of winners of major international and national level tournaments. If an Indian sportsperson performs well on the international stage, it automatically becomes important for your exams.
- <u>Miscellaneous</u> This may include information on new technological developments, celebrations related to a cultural festival, international days like the world environment day etc.

Try to inculcate the habit of **active reading**, rather than passively reading the newspaper. When you actively read the newspaper, you spend time to think and reflect upon the issue being covered, regarding its background and future implications. You may also ask yourself, "Can a question be framed on this?" Only then will you be able to take full advantage of newspaper reading.

Further, **avoid writing full sentences** while taking notes. Just noting down of facts should be enough to clear an objective test. You may keep taking notes until 1 month before the paper you seek to clear. After that, you will find that it will be very easy for you to revise these notes, prior to sitting in the exam. Intensify The Vocabulary

Though newspapers are **edited by expert groups**, you will get excellent and **unfamiliar words**. You can note down those words, and a good dictionary will give the meaning as well. By using this way, you can improve your **vocabulary power**. Understanding the words and their meanings is also helpful for a better understanding of News printed in the newspaper.

Through it, you can improvise your speaking as well as writing skills.

Improve The Reading Skills

Regular newspaper reading habit improves reading comprehension. Everybody does not know how to comprehend the **readied information correctly**. But regular reading, unintentionally, develop better reading comprehension or understanding.

Strengthen General Knowledge

The habit of reading helps to strengthen general knowledge too. The newspapers will **regularly update information, and General** knowledge helps to grow personally and professionally.

It is helpful during a personal **interview**, group discussion, interaction with the public, etc. When a student possesses knowledge related to various topics, it will be a **boon for speaking**.

Helps To Prepare For Competitive Exams

There are so many **competitive exams** at the school or college level in today's world, and competition is very high. Even before **getting a good job,** you need to give competitive exams to compete

with thousands of people. So, make your general awareness more than anyone, better the general awareness skills, better the marks obtained.

Develop Writing Skills

Not only reading a newspaper increases the **speaking skills**, it directly affects the **writing skills** of every student. In academic areas, writing skills play an essential role, and reading helps to improve **language fluency**, **leading to efficient writing**.

Reading helps to observe the writing pattern, choices of writers to organize information, express ideas, and **analyze the entire content** effectively. A better writer should be a better reader.

Improve Grammar Understanding And Writing

Grammar is the primary and **essential part of every language**. Better grammar skills are very effective for learning a language and getting a good score on examinations.

Regular newspaper reading decreases the grammatical errors made by students. It enhances the grammar because it will give you an idea of how sentences should be appropriately arranged.

Improve Memory

As newspapers deal with so many topics, there are **numerous topics** you can choose to read, and there is every topic for everyone's interest. It's introductory human psychology that humans can better memorize the things of their interests. While reading, you can **memorize the topics** that you have read, according to your interest. If reading becomes a habit, then it will **boost up your memory power.** Reading newspapers stimulates the brain, thereby slowing down the rate of turn down in Memory.

Build Up Your Personality

Reading improves general knowledge, current affairs, grammar, language fluency, writing skills, Memory, vocabulary, reading skills, self-confidence, self-expression, etc. At last, it will lead to overall personality development.
